

## UAS Community Update

The following is a list of UAS deployments for March 2024:

Below is an overview of the small unmanned aerial systems used for the last month

- On March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10 am, officers deployed a drone in the area of Sylvan and Larpenteur looking for a domestic assault suspect who had fled the scene.
- On March 5<sup>th</sup> at 11:36 pm, officers assisted the Roseville Police Department with attempting to locate a robbery suspect in the 1100 block of Larpentuer Ave West. Officers checked the area for 15 minutes with a drone.
- On March 8<sup>th</sup> at 6 am, officers responded to a person saying they were the victim of an assault but didn't know where they were. After using the cell signal to identify an area, two officers used drones to try and locate the victim.
- On March 13<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm, officers deployed a drone in the 2600 block of Larpenteur, attempting to find a missing 13-year-old. The juvenile was not missing but was picked up by one of their parents.
- On March 16<sup>th</sup> at 4 am, officers assisted the White Bear Lake Police Department in clearing a garage after an explosion occurred inside. People in the garage were mixing chemicals to make a bomb when it prematurely detonated.
- On March 27<sup>th</sup> at 12:10 pm, officers were called to the 500 block of Centruty Ave for a male present with multiple felony warrants. The male ran inside the house as officers approached. Officers monitored the house with the drone in case the suspect ran out.
