

UAS Community Update

October 1st, 2025

The following is a list of UAS deployments for September 2025:

The following is a summary of small unmanned aerial systems (UAS) deployments conducted in September 2025:

- September 3, 2025: At 1700 hours, officers deployed a drone in the 1600 block of County Road C to assist in locating a missing eight-year-old child.
- September 9, 2025: At 0930 hours, officers were dispatched to a burglary, where the suspect was armed with a handgun. Upon officers' arrival, the suspect fled on foot. The area was secured and searched with K9 teams, drones, and a helicopter. The suspect was taken into custody, trying to leave the perimeter without incident.
- September 10, 2025: At 2200 hours, officers deployed a drone in the area of 1700 Rice St. while searching for a suspect wanted for theft, burglary, and fleeing police.
- September 12, 2025: At 1700 hours, officers assisted Oakdale Police with searching rooftops for a firearm they believed may have been thrown after a shooting the night before.
- Beginning September 12, 2025, detectives conducted surveillance for two hours of a suspect wanted for robbery and criminal sexual conduct. Fights were also conducted on September 16th and 17th in relation. The case is still ongoing, and other information is being withheld.
- September 17th, 2025: Detectives deployed a drone in the area of Hazelwood and County Road D to search for two suspicious males who reportedly took an unclothed infant into a wooded area.
- September 26th, 2025: In the evening, detectives deployed drones in the area of Hazelwood Park for four hours related to a dignitary protection detail.
