

UAS Community Update

The following is a list of UAS deployments for November 2025:

The following is a summary of small unmanned aerial systems (UAS) deployments conducted in November 2025:

- November 3, 2025: At 1830 hours, officers deployed a drone in the area of Keller Golf Course. Officers were searching for a suspect wanted for felony domestic assault who had also threatened to commit suicide via firearm.
- November 4, 2025: Detectives deployed a drone in Fridley related to a search warrant they were conducting in coordination with other agencies related to burglaries. The suspect was apprehended, and the warrant was completed without incident.
- November 5, 2025: Detectives deployed a drone in the 1400 block of County Road C E during a search warrant related to a suspect wanted for aggravated assault with a firearm, felony domestic assault, and threats of violence. The suspect was arrested without incident.
- November 13, 2025: Detectives used a drone in the area of I-35E and Lapenteur related to an ongoing investigation.
- November 14, 2025: Officers deployed a drone in the 1900 Block of Upper Afton Road to provide air support for a K9 track. Officers and K9 were searching the area for suspects who committed aggravated assault (stabbing).
- November 19, 2025: Detectives conducted training at the police department.
- November 26, 2025: Officers deployed a drone in the 2300 block of White Bear Ave after two suspects stole items from a retail store and fled. The area was checked, and the suspects were not located.
- November 28, 2025: At 0100 hours, officers deployed a drone to assist North St. Paul in the 2500 block of 7th Ave E, after a gunpointing incident where the suspect fled on foot. The suspect was arrested.
