MISSION STATEMENT

The goal of the Adopt-A-Park Program is to provide an opportunity for interested parties to take part in maintaining our park system. By providing this opportunity it not only encourages and promotes community involvement but also allows us to beautify and improve our parks. All Adopt-A-Park projects should aim towards benefiting the majority of park users.

WHO?

Any individual, family, resident, group organization, or business who is eager to help beautify our parks.

WHEN?

Adoption commitment period is between April 1 and October 31. However applications are taken all throughout the year. Park clean up can be done as often as you choose, but we require a minimum of once a month dedication. After a 60 day probationary period, Maplewood Parks & Recreation will display a recognition sign for the volunteer(s) or volunteer group to be displayed at the park of their choice.

WHAT?

There are a number of services that you can provide for our parks including: picking up litter, piling up branches, raking leaves, cleaning play equipment, maintaining flowerbeds, and more! If you have any other ideas or special projects that you'd like to initiate, please check with the Parks and Recreation department.

WHY?

Maplewood is filled with wonderful and delicate natural resources which can be protected with a little attention. In addition, litter and other debris is unsightly and deflects from the natural aesthetics of our neighborhoods and beautiful parks.
