



Temporary Noise Control Waiver Request

Guidance relating to Noise Control is contained in the Maplewood City Code, Chapter 18, Article II, Division 3. All permit holders are required to be familiar with the provisions of this Ordinance and with applicable Minnesota Statutes and federal regulations. Please note:

The City of Maplewood reserves the right to revoke this waiver, based on complaint(s) received by the Police Department during the event, or violation of waiver request.

Why do I need this Temporary Permit?

- Required for any activity which produced excessive noise between the hours of 7 pm and 7 am Monday through Saturday and all day Sunday. If the noise generating activity is within 350 square feet of residential properties, notification to affected residential property owners is required.

What do I need to obtain this Temporary Permit?

- Temporary Noise Control Waiver permit application submitted through Accela.
- Flyer and list of addresses notified of event time and purpose (provided to all neighboring residential property owners within 350sq/ft. of property on which noise is generated).
 - Contact the City Clerk's Office to obtain a map of properties required to consent.

What is the Price for this Temporary Permit?

- Once the permit has been accepted an invoice will be issued for the fees:
 - Permit Fee is \$15.00
 - Payments accepted when receiving invoice
 - Cash
 - Check / Money Order
 - Credit / Debit Card
