



TEMPORARY ON-SALE 3.2% MALT LIQUOR

It is unlawful for on-sale 3.2% malt liquor to engage in any activity within the City of Maplewood, without first registering with the city. This is in compliance with the City Code, Chapter 6, article II. Applicants are required to be familiar with the ordinances and regulations associated to possessing an On-Sale 3.2% Malt Liquor Permit.

Why do I need this Temporary License?

- This permit is required for temporary on-sale 3.2 malt liquor (beer) sales by a club or charitable, religious, or other nonprofit organization.

What do I need to obtain this Temporary License?

- Temporary On-Sale 3.2% Malt Liquor Permit application submitted through Accela
- Must provide a signed lease or letter of agreement (if operating on property not owned by applicant or in conjunction with an event not coordinated by applicant) at time of application
- Certificate of Insurance naming the City of Maplewood as the certificate Holder and, in the description of operations area of the certificate, the address at which the permit will be used and the date(s) of event. Minimum amounts of coverage should be as follows:
 - \$310,000 Liquor Liability

What is the price for this Temporary License?

- Once the permit has been accepted, an invoice will be issued for the fees
 - Permit Fee of \$55 per day
 - Payments accepted when receiving invoice
 - Cash
 - Check / Money Order
 - Credit / Debit Card
