## TEMPORARY SIGN REQUIREMENTS

A temporary sign is defined as a sign used for a specific advertisement purpose that is installed for a limited duration and is not permanently attached to the ground or wall. Temporary signs include but are not limited to, banners, portable signs, advertising balloons, window signs, searchlights, or other signs or displays allowed for a limited time.

<b>Portable<sup>2</sup></b>	All zoning districts except single and double dwelling residential (and properties guided by Government or Institutional)	12 sq. ft. and over	30 days, 60 days for new business	Anywhere on the property as long as it does not obstruct traffic or pedestrian visibility. Cannot be placed in the right-of-way.	1 per property	X	

### EXEMPTIONS

<sup>1</sup>Window and Banner Sign Exemptions: Exemptions to temporary window and banner signs that exceed the size, number, or time display limits may be approved if the applicant shows there are unusual circumstances to the request. Contact the Community Development Department for additional information.

### PERMITS

<sup>2</sup>Temporary Portable Sign Permits: Sign permits must be issued prior to installation of a temporary portable sign that is 12 sq. ft. and over. Sign permits can be obtained from the Community Development Department. The sign permit carries a fee of \$45. All temporary sign installers (portable temporary signs) must be licensed by the city yearly.
